## Terrestrial & Palustrine Plant Communities Of Pennsylvania By Jean Fike

## Red maple - black ash palustrine forest

These are palustrine forests enriched by base-rich groundwater. The substrate is usually mineral soil with a thin layer of organic matter. Calciphiles characterize this community type. The dominant trees are usually Acer rubrum (red maple) and Fraxinus nigra (black ash). Associates include Quercus bicolor (swamp white oak), Nyssa sylvatica (black-gum), and Ulmus americana (American elm). Common understory species include Rhamnus alnifolia (alderleaved buckthorn), Physocarpus opulifolius (ninebark), Spiraea latifolia (meadowsweet), *Ilex verticillata* (winterberry), *Alnus serrulata* (smooth alder), Vaccinium corymbosum (highbush blueberry), and Rhododendron viscosum (swamp azalea). Common herbs include Osmunda regalis (royal fern), Carex stricta (tussock sedge), C. lacustris (lakebank sedge), Symplocarpus foetidus (skunk cabbage), Viola spp. (violets), and Onoclea sensibilis (sensitive fern). Most calciphilic species associated with this type have moderate to high light requirements, and thus are found in openings. These species include Conioselinum chinense (hemlock parsley), Trollius laxus<sup>S</sup> (spreading globeflower), Carex interior (inland sedge), C. flava<sup>S</sup> (yellow sedge), C. leptalea (bristly-stalked sedge), Cypripedium calceolus var. parviflorum<sup>S</sup> (small yellow lady's-slipper), C. reginae<sup>S</sup> (showy lady's-slipper), Geum rivale<sup>S</sup> (water avens), and Epilobium strictum (downy willow-herb).

**Related types:** The much more common "Red maple -black-gum palustrine forest" is not generally influenced by calcareous waters, and lacks the *Fraxinus nigra* (black ash) and herbaceous calciphiles that characterize this type.

Range: Glaciated NE, Glaciated NW, Piedmont, Ridge and Valley.
